Issues Decided/Positions Taken

- The Draft Meeting Summary of the January 3rd – 4th, 2013 Ocean Policy Advisory Council (OPAC) was approved by consensus with no revisions noted.
- The Council approved a motion by the vote of 7-2*, which was stated as follows:

“This is a motion to send a letter to DLCD advising of OPAC’s desire to have DLCD not file the rule and to refer the elements of the Amendment to the TSP that did not conform to the OPAC recommendation back to OPAC for review in conformance with subsection C of ORS 196.471 before the amendment and subsection 3A after the amendment; and to explore the steps necessary to initiate an amendment of the TSP under section F of the TSP and to bring that report back to the next meeting.”
