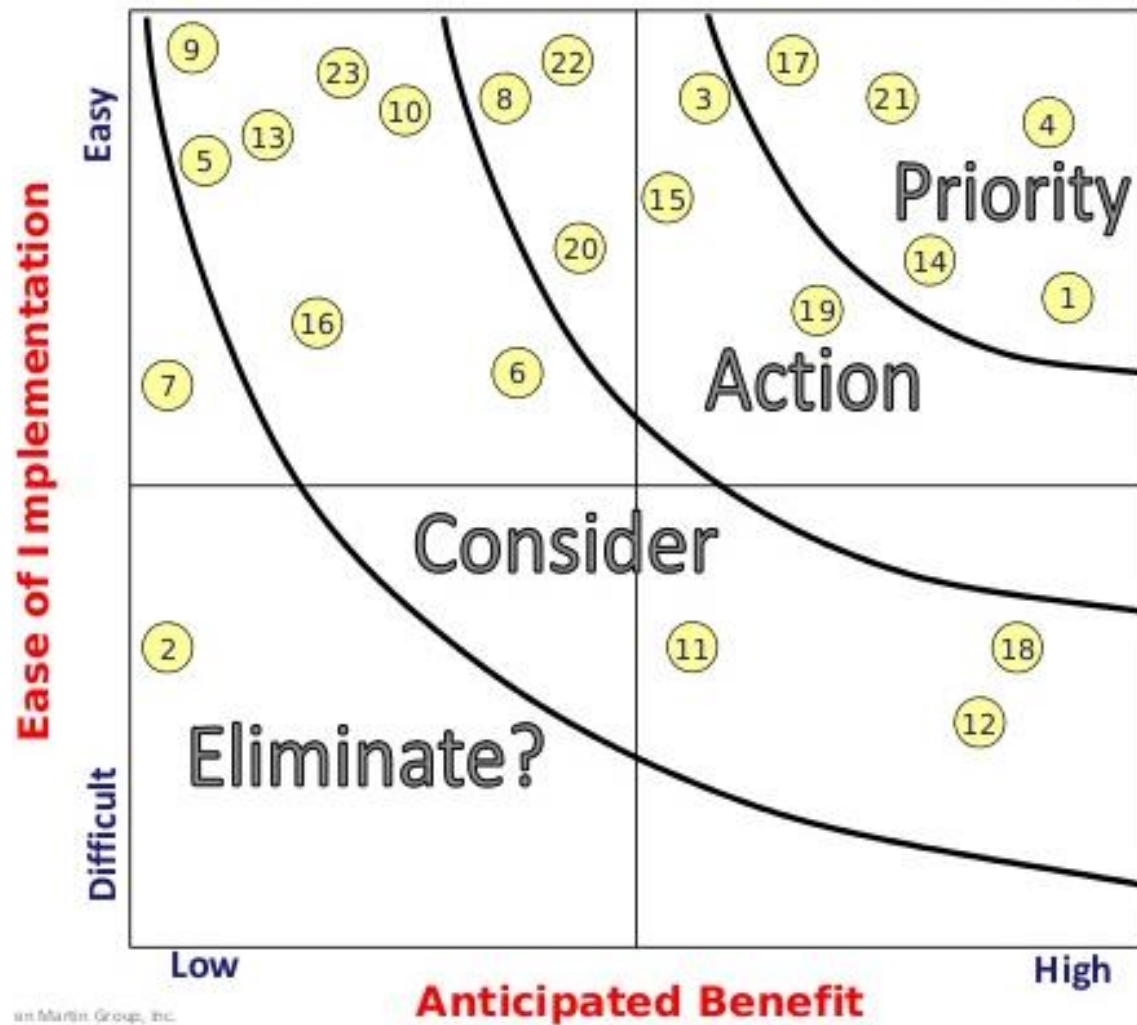


PACE Improvement Prioritization Grid - Example

Using the supplied table, or a blank sheet of paper, record notes on the following questions. Questions responses should be in the form of Yes, No, Maybe, followed by any extra notes the group would like to provide on how their decision was made.

Groups should consider the following QUESTIONS for Ease of Implementation:

1. Will this action require new policies, regulations, or programs (by State agencies or governments) in order to be accomplished?

2. Will this action require new resources (e.g., personnel time, funding, requirement) in order to be accomplished?

3. Will this action require the development of new methods, equipment, or materials in order to be accomplished?

Groups should consider the following QUESTIONS for Anticipated Benefits:

4. Will any **stakeholder groups** gain benefit (e.g., economically, culturally, recreationally) from this action?
5. Will ecosystems gain **resilience** benefits (e.g., increased biomass, diversity, or resilience) from this action?
6. Will OAH environmental factors gain **mitigation** benefits (e.g., decreased carbon imputes, lowered levels of water pollutions) from this action?

Now using post-it notes complete PACE Matrix sheet based on the groups answers (yes, no, maybe) to the questions.
