The main topics discussed during this meeting of the Territorial Sea Plan Work Group on the Rocky Shores Management Strategy (RSMS) Update included – rocky shores inventory data and the formation of a data sub-group, ratification of the public scoping summary document, and revision of RSMS Section A.

The group reviewed and brainstormed rocky shore inventory categories that should be updated and included to update the strategy with the best available information. Categories discussed included fish diversity, habitat diversity, and inclusion of more abiotic and human use characteristics.

Members then came to consensus on the [Public Process Summary Document](#) which included the materials, public responses, and other engagement initiatives that have taken place since fall 2018. The document was agreed upon with minor revisions and is now published on [www.OregonOcean.info](http://www.OregonOcean.info) and embedded in the [Citizen Guide to the Rocky Shore Management Strategy Update](#).

Finally, the group continued editing and commenting on Section A of the plan in a working document. Editing and commenting will continue independently until the next working group meeting, with a focus on Section B.
