Directions to OIMB

Take Highway 101 to Coos Bay or North Bend. Follow signs to "Ocean Beaches", "Charleston", or "Sunset Bay". Charleston is approximately eight miles from Coos Bay. As you enter Charleston, cross the South Slough bridge and turn right on Boat Basin Drive. OIMB is approximately one-half mile on the left at 63466 Boat Basin Drive. *The meeting will be held in the OIMB Dining Hall.*

Driving from Eugene takes two-and-a-half hours. Driving from Portland takes about five hours.
