Council Welcome & Updates

Welcome & agenda overview (Leif Rasmuson)

OAH Council Updates:

- The Tribal Government Representative seat is still empty. Leif Rasmuson, Laurie Juranek, and Katlyn Lockhart are continuing to reach out to various coastal tribes' natural resources teams to find an appointee.
- The Ocean Change App has completed another round of development with students at Oregon State University. The app is now ready for beta testing.
- Recorded presentations have been sent to Katlyn Lockhart from the HB 3114 projects. These videos will be available on the OAH Council website soon.
- A water quality workshop with the Pacific Coast Collaborative (PCC) and other signatories is scheduled to be held at the resource legacy fund in Sacramento in November.
- Planning has begun for the 8th Fisherman-Scientist Roundtable meeting, which will be held this Fall. This meeting will have a focus on the NOAA Ecosystem Status Reports, and NOAA Fisheries counterparts are participating in the planning process.

General Council Updates (round robin)

- The ODFW budget in reference to funding the OAH Council Staff was discussed. The budget is not final and will go to the Governor's office for review next.

Upcoming report preparation

2024 Biennial Report (Leif Rasmuson)

- The infographics for the Biennial Report were presented to the council. Feedback was provided for both and will be presented to the artists developing the graphics.
- A draft of the report will be sent out to Council members in early September.
- Keith Wolf suggested that we include a cultural relevance piece to the report by highlighting a specific fishery such as the Dory Fleet out of Pacific City.

2025 Action Plan Update (Leif Rasmuson)

- Action Plan is planned to be updated by June 30, 2025.
- The council discussed the potential for an in-person workshop to start updating the Action Plan.
