Visioning Exercise - List of Potential Council Activities

At the upcoming December 3rd, 2015 meeting of the Ocean Policy Advisory Council, there will be a discussion of the future activities of the council. The list of items below was drafted through previous meetings of the council, and will be considered as a starting point for the visioning exercise the council will conduct during the meeting. Members of the council and members of the public are welcome to provide additional topics for discussion at the December 3rd meeting, (ideas from the public are welcome during the public comment period).

- Discussion about committee (forming one) that coastwide talks about the issue of gillnetting.
- How to get ODFW budget cuts effectively implemented. ODFW commission practices splitting fishing vs wildlife.
- DLCD commission composition : to get an ocean knowledgeable representative
- Rocky Shore Intertidal Management Areas review and evaluation of areas studied as part of that plan.
- Spatial Planning of the offshore
- Stakeholder outreach and OPAC connection to make sure social and economic effects of MR's don't suffer.
- Data that we use is defensible and "real" from an evaluation perspective... For example making sure that information that we use is defensible and "real" from an evaluation perspective.
- Commercial Marine Algae harvest Issue
- Ocean Acidification

 - o A public forum on OA as an educational event?
- Review the Territorial Sea Plan... periodically review from the purposes of evaluating the other parts of TSP. potentially form a subcommittee to look at this.
